



## Highlights of Andalusia.

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**SPAIN | 8DAYS / 7NIGHTS**

Route: From and to Malaga

## TOUR OVERVIEW

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Andalusia - a land of contrasts with an impressive cultural heritage, delicious food and a spectacular countryside. The tour has been designed so that you can enjoy this very special region of Spain visiting the main monumental sites.

## DAY BY DAY

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### DAY 1 | MALAGA

Arrival and transfer to your hotel in the Costa del Sol, or "Sun Coast". Enjoy the rest of the day at your leisure.

- **Overnight stay in Torremolinos on a half-board basis.**

### DAY 2 | TORREMOLINOS – RONDA – GIBRALTAR - JEREZ (340km)

Drive to Ronda. This old town is situated either side of the spectacular El Tajo gorge. Guided visit of the Santa Maria la Mayor church, a typical Andalusian house and the famous bullring, the oldest in Spain. Drive to Gibraltar, the last English colony in Europe. The visit of the Gibraltar Rock takes around two hours by minibus. Several stops will be made, some of them being Europe Point, the monkeys and Saint Michael's cave. Drive to Jerez after the visit.

\*Note: Gibraltar - Visa is required for some nationalities! Please, get in contact with us for more information.

- **Overnight stay in Jerez de la Frontera on a half-board basis.**

### DAY 3 | JEREZ DE LA FRONTERA – CADIZ – SEVILLA (130km)

Jerez, world-famous for its sherry production and horses. Visit the Royal Equestrian School and one of the typical bodegas with sherry tasting. Drive to Cadiz, the oldest inhabited town of the Spanish peninsula. Walking tour of town centre. Continue to Seville, the capital of Andalusia, known for its typical Spanish atmosphere and impressive architecture.

- **Overnight stay in Seville on a half-board basis.**



### DAY 4 | SEVILLA

Panoramic tour of the city with photo stops at the Plaza de España, Plaza de America and María Luisa Park. Typical lunch with a variety of delicious tapas in a typical Sevillian restaurant in the historical city centre. In the afternoon, enjoy a half-day tour including visit of the Alcázar Royal Palace, the Cathedral (third largest in the world) and the Santa Cruz quarter with its charming narrow streets and idyllic patios.

- **Overnight stay in Seville on a half-board basis.**

### DAY 5 | SEVILLA – CORDOBA – GRANADA (310km)

Drive to Córdoba. Do a guided city tour, including visit of the impressive mosque/cathedral, the Mezquita, with its 850 marble columns. Take a walking tour through the picturesque streets of the Jewish quarter. Depart to Granada.

- **Overnight stay in Granada on a half-board basis.**

### DAY 6 | GRANADA

Guided visit through the famous Alhambra with its stunning palaces, Moorish architecture, and renowned Generalife gardens (a World Heritage Site and named by some as 'The 8th Wonder of the World'). Walk through the historic Albaicín quarter, which has existed since Moorish times.

- **Overnight stay in Granada on a half-board basis.**

## DAY 7 | GRANADA – ALFARNATEJO – MALAGA (145km)

Depart to Alfaratejo, a 'white village' located in Malaga's mountains. As part of this unique experience, you will have the opportunity to visit an olive mill and enjoy lunch in a private house, where you will taste typical dishes cooked and elaborated by the owner (approx. 6-8 pax per house). Drive to Malaga.

- **Overnight stay in Malaga on a half-board basis.**

## DAY 8 | DEPARTURE

Transfer to Malaga airport for your departure flight or to your selected hotel on the coast for those extending their stay on the Costa del Sol.
